1. Appearance

Hair: Unless otherwise specified, our standard hairstyle is a low bun with the hair parted on the dancers left side (hair brushed to the right). Bangs **MUST** be off the face. Hairnets are required for your bun, and can be found at drug stores. They keep your bun nice and neat. Please be sure your hair and headpieces are tightly secured. Hair should be done before arriving to the school. Please part short hair the same way and secure with a barrette.

Hair Pieces: All hair pieces will be worn on the right side of the dancers head, above their bun and opposite of their left part.

Make-up: The purpose of stage make-up is to be sure that the dancer's face is not "washed out" in the stage lights. Please apply your average amount of make-up (blush, maroon lipstick (no red), brown eye shadow). Older girls may add mascara, eyeliner, foundation, powder, etc. Make-up should be applied before coming to the school. No nail polish, except for clear. No jewelry at all!

Costumes: PLEASE LABEL EVERYTHING! Shoes, headpieces, tights, you name it. Before you leave your house, please triple check that you have everything you need- all garments and accessories. One suggestion would be to put all accessory items in a large zip-loc bag labeled with the dancers name and song. **NO** underwear! The main reason for this is the noticeable panty lines. In addition, in many costumes, the underwear sticks out. This is why tights are required even with costumes consisting of pants, to offer the appropriate coverage. For dancers with more than one dance, you must change immediately into your next performance costume.

Costume Care: Please do not wear your costume at home or eat in your costume. If something happens to a dancers costume or it is misplaced they will not be able to participate in that dance. If they eat a snack or drink in their costume during the dress rehearsal or performance they must wear a full cover up to ensure the costume stays clean. Do not machine wash any costumes. If your costume has a full skirt or tutu, hang the costume up side down to keep it fluffy and wrinkle free. When transporting costumes please use a garment bag as the Pointe of Grace staff has spent countless hours steaming, ironing, and getting the costumes performance ready.

Recital Hair & Makeup Tips

Tips On How To Do A Ballet Bun

1. Part the hair over the dancers left eye (left part).
2. Lightly wet the dancers hair once parted.
3. Use a comb or brush to smooth the hair and pull it into a low ponytail.
4. Once it is in a low ponytail, secure the hair with gel or hairspray to ensure that there are no stray hairs or “whispies”.
5. Begin to twist the ponytail clockwise around the dancers hair tie. To ensure a secure bun, apply bobby pins to the hair as you twist the bun.
6. Once the hair is securely bobby pinned into a bun, you will use a hair net that will wrap around the bun. The hair net will secure any stray hairs. After the hair net has been wrapped around the bun, you will need to use a few more bobby pins to secure it in place. Hairnets can be purchased at your local drug store (walgreens, CVS, target, walmart, etc.)
7. Your dancers hair will look beautiful! Secure it with a few more sprays of hair spray and you are set! ***There should be no wisps of hair flying around. If need to use bobby pins or clips to keep stray hairs in place, use ones that match their hair color.***

Tips On How To Do “Stage Make-up”

1. Foundation/Powder
2. Eye Shadow
3. Black Eyeliner
4. Mascara on top and bottom lashes
5. Blush sweep diagonally outward on cheekbone
6. Maroon Lipstick

****ADDITIONAL NOTES****

- 1.) All shoes should be labeled on the inside of the shoe with dancer’s name or initials.
- 2.) Initial your child’s costumes on the inside tag. Initial all hairpieces and tights.
- 3.) Tights should be clean with no runs or holes in them.
- 4.) Shoes should be clean with no holes in them.
- 5.) No nail polish on fingers or toes.
- 6.) No extra jewelry - rings, earrings, double piercings, necklaces, fake tattoos, ankle bracelets, etc.

4. Day of Show Check In & Out Process

For students in ages 2-5 year old classes & K-3rd classes

When entering the school, you will wait in the Tompkins PAC lobby until directed to go to the choir room.

Check In: The check in process is easy. While waiting in line you will take a laminated number. Your child's class will have a sign in & out form on the bulletin board. You will sign your child in, write your phone number, and the laminated number you received.

You will drop them off at the choir room door and they will be escorted to their class mom.

Students who danced in Act I will be signed out during intermission by their guardian. I repeat, no dancers will be released prior to intermission (unless previous arrangements have been made with the teachers). We encourage families to watch the remainder of the show as all students have worked very hard for recital. Also, watching our older dancers inspires your little one's to see what they too will accomplish one day.

Check Out: During intermission you will line up in the hallway outside of the choir room. A few parents at a time will be allowed in the choir room to sign their child out and return their laminated number to the class parent. Please be patient while checking out your child. Our policy is in place to ensure the safety of your child and to confirm that the same parent who signed them in is the same parent who signs them out.

For students ages 8+

You will sign your child in and out on the forms posted on the wall near the black box. Your child will be in the backstage black box during the show. No costume changes will occur in the black box. If your child is in more than one dance and needs to change their costumes they will change in the theater room. Company members will change in the dressing rooms.

Boy students age 8+

You will be in the back stage black box. No costume changes will occur in the black box. If you need to change a costume you will change in the boys bathroom and return to the black box once you have changed.

What if my child is in more than one dance?

If your child has a costume change and they cannot change themselves, you are responsible for changing their outfit and getting them with their next dance. We encourage being a volunteer class parent.

What to bring?

Please bring water and a labeled bag of activities for your child while they are waiting to dance. Coloring pages, tablet, toys, crayons (no markers), etc. POG is not responsible for any misplaced items. No eating in costumes or in the dressing rooms.

Lap children, 2 and under, do not need to purchase a ticket. If your child will take up a seat, you will need to purchase them a ticket.

6. Dress Rehearsal Friday, June 2nd at Tompkins High School.

For 2-5 year old classes!

2-5 year old classes will **NOT** have a dress rehearsal at Tompkins High School on Friday, June 2nd. During their weekly class time the final week of classes, May 29th – June 2nd, they will come in full costume (hair, make-up, tights, shoes, costume, hair piece). They will practice their walk-on/ off & dance. This will be their dress rehearsal time. I repeat, **2-5 year old classes do NOT need to come to the dress rehearsal on Friday, June 2nd.**

For K-3rd & Fri 4th & up classes!

K-3rd classes & Fri 4th & up class will have their dress rehearsal on Friday, June 2nd at Tompkins High School. **Their call time is 4:30 pm.** When they are done rehearsing they are free to leave, unless they have more dances.

For Hip-Hop Classes!

Hip- Hop class will have their dress rehearsal on Friday, June 2nd at Tompkins High School. **Their call time is 5:00 pm.** When they are done rehearsing they are free to leave, unless they have more dances.

For all other dances!

All other classes will have their dress rehearsal on Friday, June 2nd at Tompkins High School. **Their call time is 5:15 pm.** More specific call times & rehearsal order will be released soon.

When you arrive to the school wait in the Tompkins Performing Arts Center audience. We will call classes up to the stage to rehearse. It is crucial that you arrive on time to your call time. Get ready at home including shoes, hair, makeup, and costume so that you will not miss your rehearsal time. For students 7 and under, one parent/guardian is required to stay on the premise with the child during dress rehearsal (optional for 8+). One parent per child please and no siblings.

For dress rehearsal, students with multiple dances will change in the “black box” dressing room backstage.

No company dances will run their dances during dress rehearsal.

7. Parent volunteers

For day of show, we are seeking 2-3 parent volunteers for each class listed in the sign up genius. Class parents will be responsible for supervising your class in the dressing room, taking kids to the restroom, and walking them to the back stage area. You will watch their dance from backstage or you can watch from the side of the audience.

We are also seeking parent volunteers to help with (1) Lobby Merchandise, Concession, & Ticketing Table (2) Trophy, Medal, Flower Pick Up Table (3) Backstage Helpers (4) Ushers.

Parent volunteers will need to attend an information meeting **May 31st at 9am or 7:30pm**. Please contact us if you wish to volunteer but are unable to attend one of the meetings!

Recital Flowers: Take your pick of a bouquet of 3, 6 or dozen red roses to present to your dancer at the end of their show. Flowers can be picked up at the flower table-at the performance venue, the day of your dancer's performance. **Orders are due May 12th.**

Recital Trophy and Medal: Pre order a trophy, medal or both to present to your dancer at the end of their show. They can be picked up at the trophy/medal table-at the performance venue, the day of your dancer's performance. The engraving, on the trophy and medal, will read "Pointe of Grace Dance Studio, Recital 2016-2017." **Orders are due May 12th.**

Recital DVD: All 3 shows will be on one DVD. You will receive your video by mid summer. You will be notified via email when they arrive at the studio. **Orders will be due June 2nd.**
